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******Exciting Environmental Entrepreneurship Program for Teens 15–17 begins in January 2018.******



Teens Learn, Earn, and Return...In this dualtrack program, teens have the opportunity to learn real-world business skills along with knowledge of ecosystems gardening. In spring, students receive a stipend to attend 16 sessions once a week for two hours afterschool.

In summer, teens work with college interns to set up a gar-

dening service where they sell and install beautiful, low-maintenance native flowers, shrubs, and grasses on properties throughout Waltham. Students earn an hourly wage to develop 21st century career-readiness skills that prepare them for jobs and academic pursuits.
