JOB DUTIES: Primary duty will be to assist the Wildlife Diversity Program Manager as a Pollinator Ecologist. Coordinate, conduct and assist with the collection of field, survey and other data to evaluate at-risk pollinator abundance and habitat as identified in the Nebraska Natural Legacy Project. Biologist will be the lead contact in coordinating pollinator project activities among participating agencies, data entry, and analysis. Will assist with or be responsible for report writing and disseminating information to agency personnel and the public. Biologist will work with pollinator habitat improvement projects. Completion of other duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, & ABILITIES: Advanced knowledge of native wildlife and pollinator management and ecology principles. Strong analytical, writing, and communication skills are essential as well as pollinator and native flowering plant identification, a working knowledge of data entry and database management. Ability to operate handheld GPS units, 4x4 vehicles, All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVs). Experience with MS Access, MS Excel, Program R or other statistics packages, Geographic Information Systems (GIS), PowerPoint, and design software programs is highly desirable. Applicant must be able to tolerate occasionally working odd hours, in remote areas, harsh weather conditions and intermittent travel requiring overnight stays away from home.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS: Bachelor's degree in biology, ecology, fish or wildlife management or closely related field of biological science or equivalent experience.
